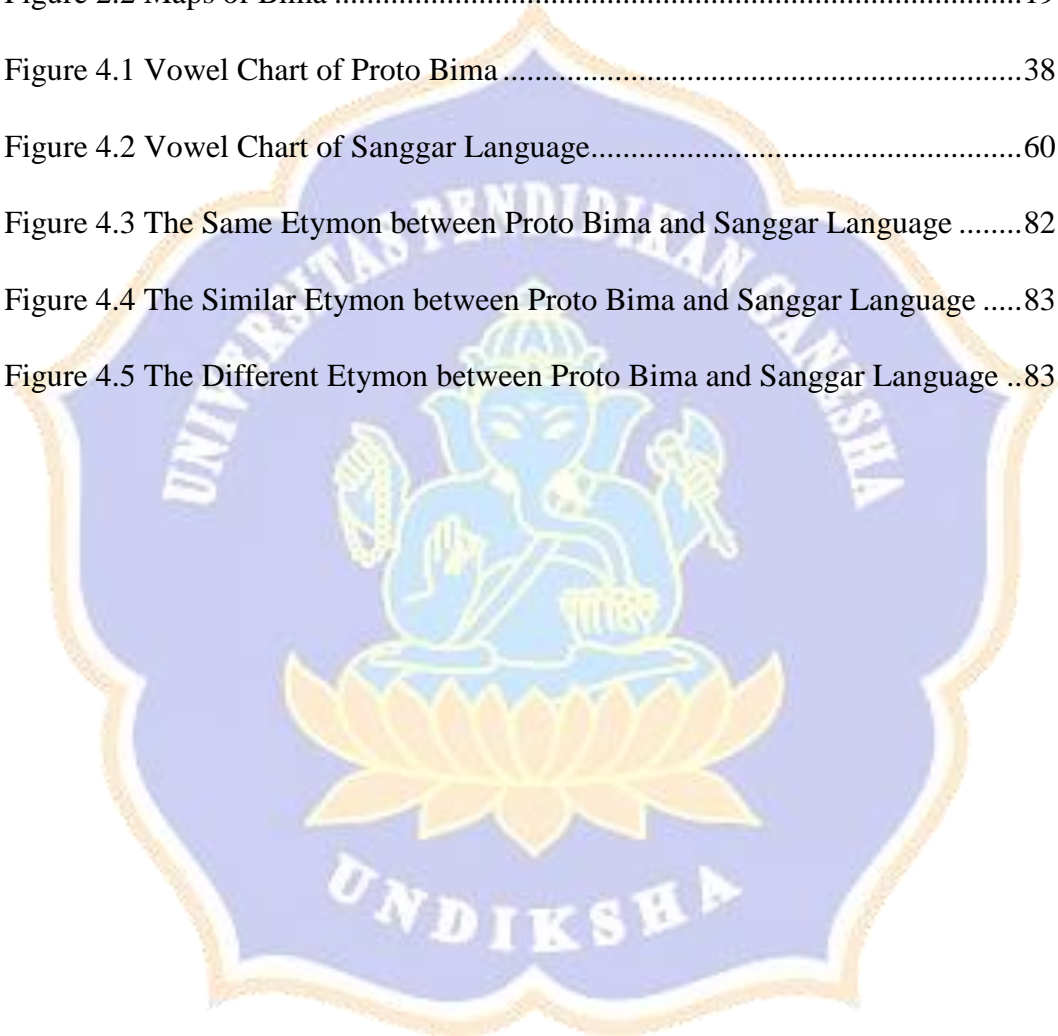
- [ʌ] : central, open-mid, neutral vocoid

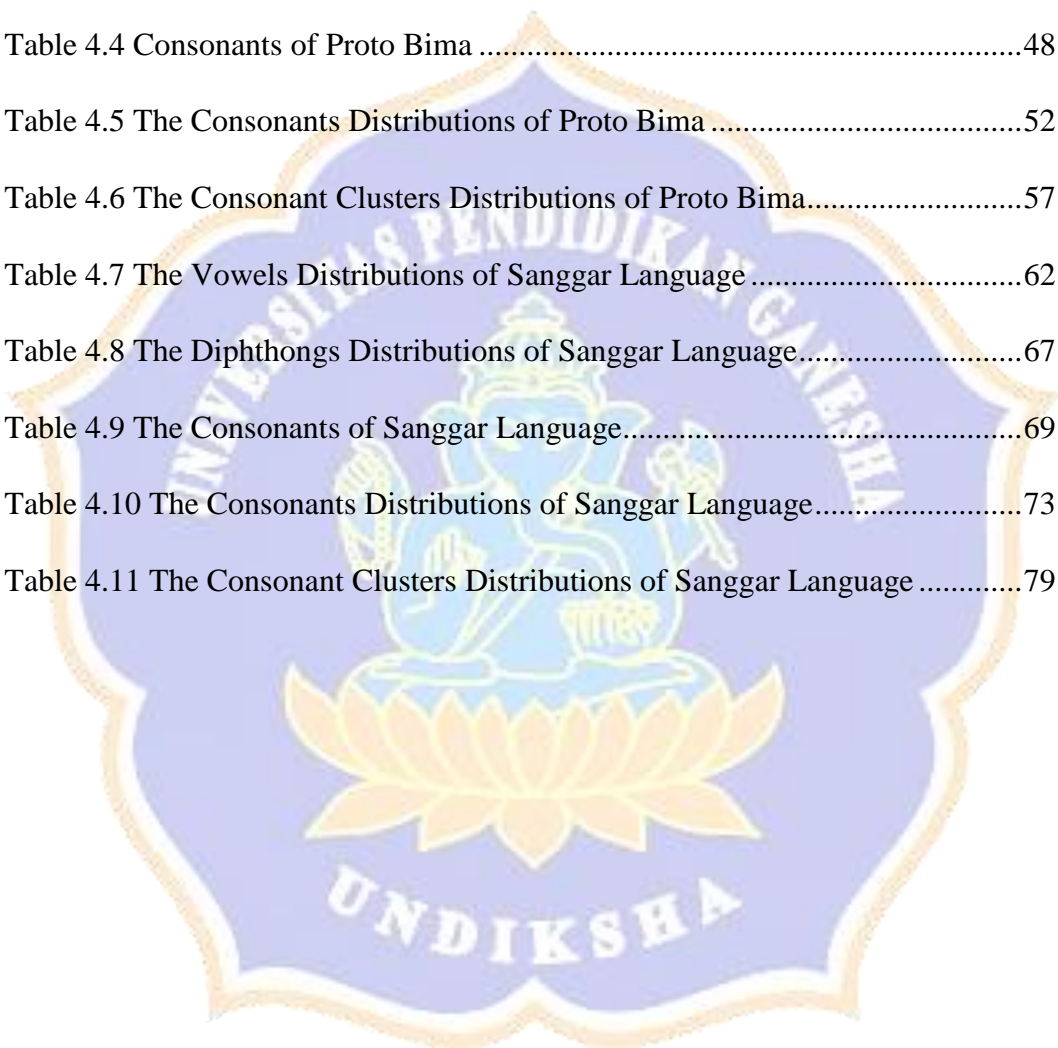
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
