[p] : voiceless, bilabial, stop/plosive consonant

[b] : voiced, bilabial, stop/plosive consonant

[t] : voiceless, alveolar, stop/plosive consonant

[f] : voiceless, labiodental, fricative consonant

[d] : voiced, alveolar, stop/plosive consonant

[h] : voiceless, glottal, fricative consonant

- [w] : voiced, bilabial, approximant consonant



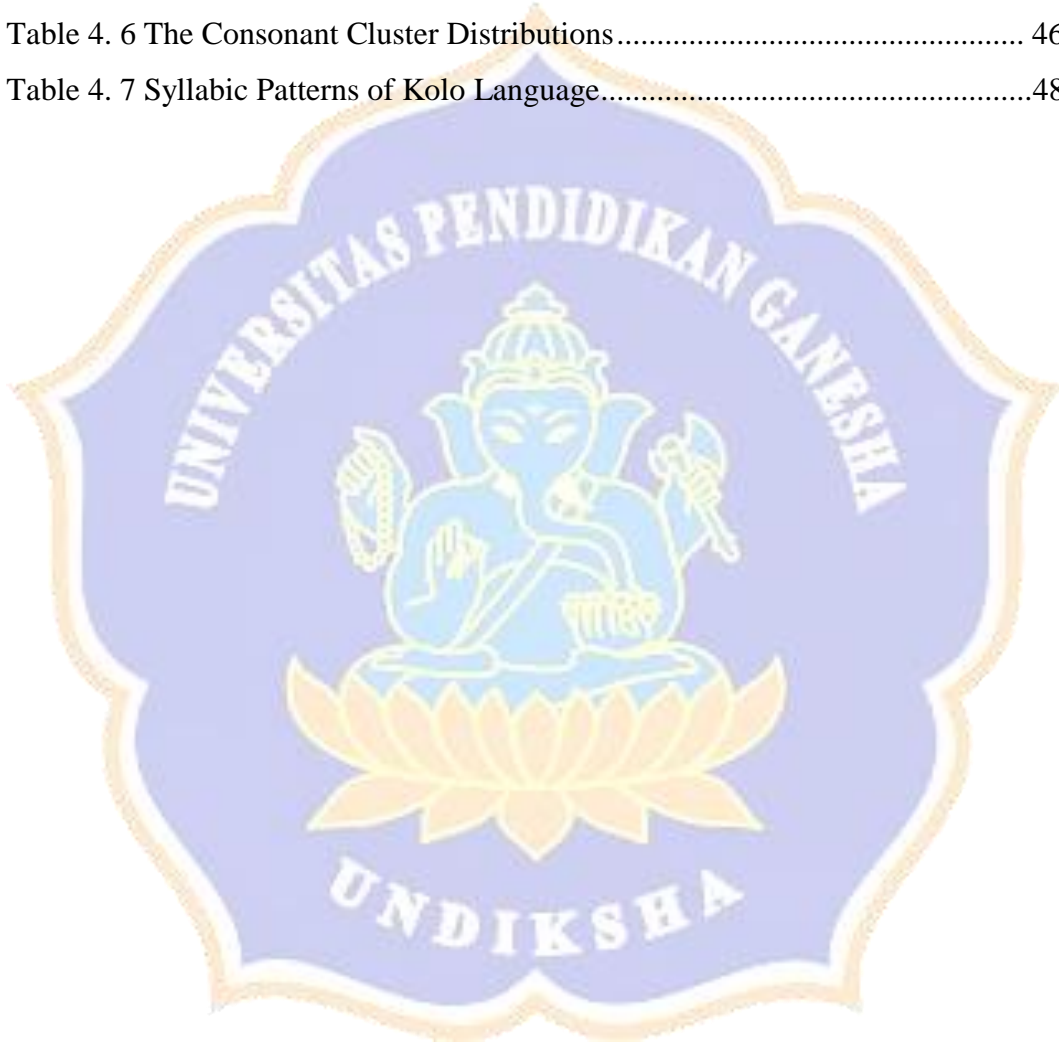
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
