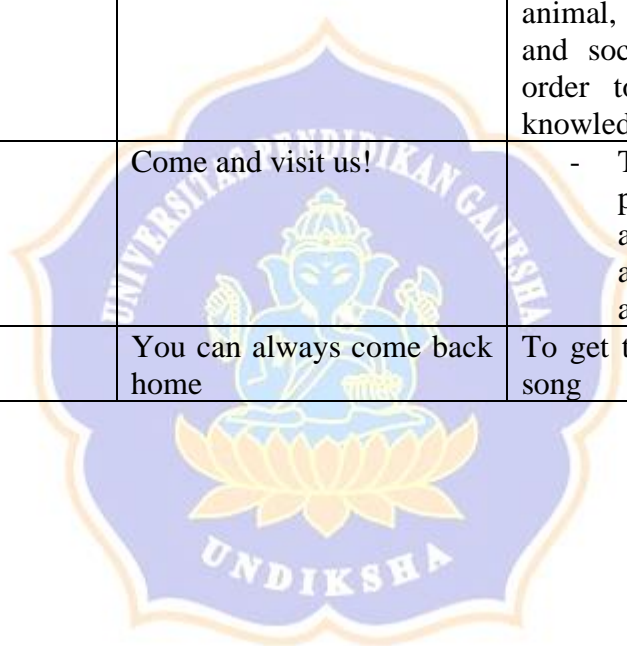


Appendix 2. About the Author and the Textbook
