

Because of the situation, the used of textbook while online learning is not optimal because teacher frequently use PowerPoint or other media and rarely use the English textbook during the class. However, while the offline learning, the English textbook is the main media in teaching-learning process that make it used optimally during the learning process.
4.	Do you create other reading activities in addition to the activities available in the students' book? What activities do you create? What are the purposes to create new activities?	The reading activities is focusing on the reading activities that provided in the textbook, but it added by teacher sometime if it is needed. The activity that usually added by teacher such as asking some questions after reading a text, finding unfamiliar words, and then finding its meaning. Although the reading activities provided in the English textbook already categorized as the complete one, the new activities are created to avoid monotonous and make students enjoy the learning process.
5.	How do students respond to the reading activity that has been done?	During the teaching-learning process, students are very excited and take a role during the class. However, there are still some students who choose to be inactive and did not take a role during the class.
