Appendix 7. The result of Interview Analysis using thematic Analysis

A. Transkrip Data

T1

Q1: How can self-assessment be useful to improve students' competency in writing? Answer: It can be useful for students as a self-reflection to know better how to write correctly and they also have a portfolio of their abilities so that they can improve their competency in writing for the better. So, with self-assessment, they can find out if their abilities are good or still lacking so that they can better improve themselves in writing competence.

Q2: How can self-assessment increase students' motivation to improve their writing competence?

Answer: with self-assessment, they can be motivated to improve themselves, especially students can be motivated to be able to write well, they become more aware of the abilities they have and they are motivated to develop their abilities to be better at writing.

Q3: What to expect after students use self-assessment?

Answer: with self-assessment, it is hoped that they can be independent and confident in writing, so that they are no longer dependent on their friends when making a piece of writing so that they can achieve or hone their competence in writing independently and confidently.

Q4: How can self-assessment help teachers assess students' writing competence? Answer: Self-assessment certainly helps teachers see student achievement in writing. In addition, teachers can also more easily find out the ability of students who are still lacking so that teachers can find suitable methods to improve students' abilities, especially in writing.

Q5: What challenges do you face in applying self-assessment in the field of writing? Answer: they are not used to self-assessment so they will tend to be dishonest. When their friends have finished doing the self-assessment, students tend to feel pressured and not confident in filling out the self-assessment so they tend to fill out the self-assessment dishonestly. In addition, students also still feel hesitant because they themselves are also confused about whether their abilities are good or not. To overcome this, teachers supervise students while they conduct self-assessments.

Q1: How can self-assessment be useful to improve students' competence in writing? Answer: A self-assessment is useful to students as a self-reflection in writing. Self-assessment is given to students as a reflection or enrichment of what they have done. If after getting self-assessment but their abilities still have to be improved, then self-assessment will be given on an ongoing basis so that students can better understand what they make and what abilities they should improve again, especially in writing.

Q2: How can self-assessment increase students' motivation to improve their writing competence?

Answer: By using self-assessment, students feel motivated to improve their writing skills, especially they can find out what needs to be improved in writing competence so that they can improve their writing for the better.

Q3: What to expect after students use self-assessment?

Answer: From the application of this self-assessment, surely the hope desired by the teacher is the improvement of students in writing competence. Where, teachers hope that after students use self-assessment, they can find out their weaknesses and strengths in writing, and they are more motivated to be able to come up with new ideas in writing.

Q4: How can self-assessment help teachers assess students' writing competence? Answer: A self-assessment can assist teachers in assessing or seeing significant progress. Where from before using self-assessment, they do not know their weaknesses and strengths in writing, so that self-assessment ethics have been applied, they can find out what weaknesses and strengths they have, with that, teachers are also helped in knowing students' abilities in writing.

Q5: What challenges do you face in applying self-assessment in the field of writing? Answer: The obstacle faced when applying self-assessment is that students are still confused about what they should value in themselves. With that, students become less courageous to explore their shortcomings and strengths in writing so they tend to ask questions with their friends.

Q1: How can self-assessment be useful to improve students' competence in writing? Answer: Self-assessment is very useful for students as a self-reflection in improving their ability in writing where students are encouraged to further improve their understanding and competence in writing so that students will be able to produce better writing.

Q2: How can self-assessment increase students' motivation to improve their writing competence?

Answer: with self-assessment, students have a better understanding of what they have written, which at first, they are still lacking in writing skills, after getting self-assessment they can improve or improve their skills in the field of writing.

Q3: What to expect after students use self-assessment?

Answer: It is expected that students will further improve their writing skills as they can create new ideas, and the greatest hope is that they can know the things they need to improve in their writing so that it will affect the quality of the writing they make.

Q4: How can self-assessment help teachers assess students' writing competence? Answer: A self-assessment is very helpful for teachers in assessment, especially to find out how far students are able to write, where from this assessment teachers can more easily find out the improvements or changes that occur in student writing so as to facilitate teachers in assessment.

Q5: What challenges do you face in applying self-assessment in the field of writing? Answer: The obstacle faced is that students often feel confused about what they need to assess in themselves in writing, so students tend to answer self-assessments dishonestly making the results of self-assessment less accurate.

Q1: How can self-assessment be useful to improve students' competence in writing? Answer: Self-assessment is very useful for improving or improving student

competence. Where in self-assessment, students will get feedback on self-assessment that has been done so that from this feedback they can improve their competence in writing. And this assessment is also applied on an ongoing basis until students are able to achieve competence in writing.

Q2: How can self-assessment increase students' motivation to improve their writing competence?

Answer: Self-assessment can increase students' motivation in developing ideas in their writing. Students will be able to develop new ideas in writing and they can pour these ideas into their writing with confidence.

Q3: What to expect after students use self-assessment?

Secondly, the learning process is student-centered as students can assess their own abilities and they can more easily come up with ideas. From that, students' needs will be achieved according to their characteristics.

Q4: How can self-assessment help teachers assess students' writing competence? Answer: Self-assessment is very helpful for teachers, of course, to better know the abilities or characteristics of each student. In addition, with self-assessment, teachers can also find out whether the methods used are suitable or not so that teachers can also improve the methods used in writing learning.

Q5: What challenges do you face in applying self-assessment in the field of writing? Answer: In the application of self-assessment, the obstacles experienced are limitations in technology. As we know that in the current era technology is required in education. However, some teachers are still not very familiar in using technology so that the strategies used to implement self-assessment tend to still use conventional strategies so that responses to the results of self-assessment tend to be filled in dishonestly or carelessly because their own students feel uninterested in filling out self-assessment with methods that they think are boring.

Q1: How can self-assessment be useful to improve students' competence in writing? Answer: Self-assessment can be useful as self-reflection to improve writing skills so that students can find out their weaknesses in writing then they can improve their weaknesses to be better in the future. From self-assessment, students will also know better how to write correctly in accordance with the context.

Q2: How can self-assessment increase students' motivation to improve their writing competence?

Answer: Self-assessment can increase student motivation in writing by using suitable strategies so that students are motivated to create a writing that is appropriate to the context such as structure, social function, linguistic elements in a sentence. So from this, they can further develop their vocabulary in writing.

Q3: What to expect after students use self-assessment?

Q4: How can self-assessment help teachers assess students' writing competence? Answer: of course, self-assessment can help teachers in providing assessments, one
