

**GAMBARAN PELAKSANAAN *CLEANLINESS, HEALTH, SAFETY & ENVIRONMENT SUSTAINABILITY (CHSE) VILLA DI DESA KALIANGET, BULELENG TAHUN 2023***

**ABSTRAK**

Pemerintah Indonesia telah mengeluarkan beberapa kebijakan untuk mengatasi meningkatkan pariwisata di Bali pasca Pandemi Covid-19 salah satunya melalui program *Cleanliness, Health, Safety, and Environmental Sustainability (CHSE)*. Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian observasional dengan analisis data deskriptif kuantitatif dengan menggunakan total sampling. Penelitian dilakukan di desa Kalianget, Buleleng dengan populasi subjek penelitian 5 Unit Vila. Menggunakan alat ukur yaitu Kuesioner Modifikasi Pedoman CHSE *Homestay/Pondok Wisata* Kementerian Pariwisata dan Ekonomi Kreatif Tahun 2020. Data hasil kuesioner yang didapatkan berupa data ordinal yang digolongkan secara kategori berdasarkan kriteria baik, cukup, dan kurang. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui gambaran pelaksanaan pedoman CHSE pada Villa di Desa Kalianget, Buleleng pada Tahun 2023. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa vila-vila di Desa Kalianget menunjukkan hasil kategori CHSE cukup dengan rerata nilai kuesioner sebesar 82.80 (61.5%). Villa K menunjukkan nilai tertinggi sebesar 95 poin, sementara Villa M memiliki nilai terendah sebesar 61 poin. Secara umum, kriteria CHSE yang belum terpenuhi di Villa Desa Kalianget terutama berkaitan dengan protokol kesehatan, seperti pengukuran suhu, pengaturan jarak, dan penggunaan alat pelindung diri seperti masker dan sarung tangan.

**ABSTRACT**

The Indonesian government has issued several policies to address the increasing tourism in Bali after the Covid-19 pandemic, one of which is through the Cleanliness, Health, Safety, and Environmental Sustainability (CHSE) program. This research is observational research with quantitative descriptive data analysis using total sampling. The research was conducted in Kalianget village, Buleleng, with a research subject population of 5 villa units. Using a measuring instrument, namely the 2020 Modified Questionnaire for CHSE Homestay/Tourist Lodge Guidelines of the Ministry of Tourism and Creative Economy. The data obtained from the questionnaire results is in the form of ordinal data, which is classified into categories based on the criteria of good, sufficient, and poor. This research aims to provide an overview of the implementation of CHSE guidelines at villas in Kalianget Village, Buleleng, in 2023. The research results show that the villas in Kalianget Village exhibit adequate CHSE category results with an average questionnaire score of 82.80 (61.5%). Villa K shows the highest score of 95 points, while Villa M has the lowest score of 61 points. In general, the CHSE criteria that have not been met at Kalianget Village Villa are mainly related to health protocols, such as measuring temperature, setting distance, and using personal protective equipment such as masks and gloves.
