









1. Do you agree that a good English teacher should be able to give all students equal opportunities?

M1

I agree, because all students are here to learn, so everyone should also get the same opportunity to get various things in learning activities.

M2

I agree, because usually only the smart ones are paid attention to so those of us with low abilities are left behind and end up with unsatisfactory grades in the learning results report.
