
## **Normal Q-Q Plots**










# **Detrended Normal Q-Q Plots**






#### Criteria of Perception of Undergraduate Students of English Major




#### Criteria of Perception of Undergraduate Students of Non-English Major



#### Criteria of Perception of Postgraduate Students of English Major




#### Criteria of Perception of Postgraduate Students of Non-English Major
