

ABSTRAK

Pelayanan kebidanan secara menyeluruh adalah rangkaian layanan kesehatan yang diberikan secara berkesinambungan untuk membantu mengidentifikasi komplikasi secara dini dan meningkatkan kesehatan. Tujuan laporan difokuskan pada pemberian pelayanan kebidanan komprehensif bagi ibu hamil trimester III, bersalin, nifas, BBL, dan neonatus sesuai standar pelayanan kebidanan. Asuhan dilakukan pada Perempuan “LD” G3P2A0 usia kehamilan 36 minggu 6 hari hingga masa nifas dan neonatus selesai. Temuan menunjukkan bahwa Selama masa gestasi, ibu melaporkan adanya keluhan nyeri sebagai bentuk ketidaknyamanan yang dirasakan dan diberikan penatalaksanaan prenatal yoga. Seluruh tahapan persalinan berlangsung secara fisiologis mulai kala I sampai kala IV sertatindakan sesuai standar, termasuk manajemen aktif kala III dan penjahitan laserasi grade I. Dalam periode nifas, kondisi ibu baik, involusi uterus berjalan normal, pengeluaran ASI lancar, serta luka perineum sembuh serta baik. Asuhan pada BBL menunjukkan bayi lahir spontan, cukup bulan, sertakondisi *vigorous baby*, berat badan lahir 4.000 gram, refleks baik, serta tidak ditemukan tanda bahaya. Pelayanan neonatus dilakukan melalui kunjungan neonatus sertahasil pertumbuhan dan perkembangan bayi dalam batas normal serta pemberian imunisasi sesuai jadwal. Pembahasan menunjukkan bahwa sebagian besar asuhan yang diberikan telah sesuai serta teori, terdapat kesenjangan dalam pelaksanaan asuhan BBL, yaitu tidak dilakukan pembersihan muka bayi saat kepala bayi lahir, tindakan jepit potong tali pusat yang tidak sesuai prosedur, pelaksanaan IMD yang dilakukan kurang dari waktu yang dianjurkan, serta tidak dilakukan pengukuran TFU pada kunjungan nifas KF 2. Secara keseluruhan asuhan telah diterapkan berjalan baik dan menunjang kesehatan ibu dan bayi. Oleh sebab itu kedepannya penulis, tenaga kesehatan, maupun fasilitas pelayanan kesehatan diharapkan mampu meningkatkan kualitas pelayanan serta berpedoman pada standar asuhan kebidanan sehingga pelayanan yang diberikan lebih optimal.

ABSTRACT

Comprehensive midwifery care is a series of health services provided on an ongoing basis to help identify complications early and improve health. The purpose of this report is to focus on the provision of comprehensive midwifery care for pregnant women in their third trimester, during labor, in the postpartum period, for newborns, and for neonates in accordance with midwifery care standards. Care is provided from the third trimester of pregnancy through the postpartum period and until the neonate is fully established. Findings indicate that during gestation, the mother reported experiencing pain as a form of discomfort and was provided with prenatal yoga as a management strategy. All stages of labor proceeded physiologically from the first stage through the fourth stage, with interventions performed according to standards, including active management of the third stage and suturing of a Grade I perineal laceration. During the postpartum period, the mother's condition was good, uterine involution proceeded normally, breast milk flow was unimpeded, and the perineal wound healed well. Care for the newborn indicated a spontaneous, full-term birth; the baby was vigorous with good reflexes, and no signs of distress were found. Neonatal care was provided through neonatal visits, with the baby's growth and development within normal limits and immunizations administered according to schedule. The discussion indicates that most of the care provided was in accordance with theory; however, there were gaps in the implementation of newborn care, namely the failure to clean the infant's face when the head emerged and the failure to clamp and cut the umbilical cord. Overall, the care provided has been implemented effectively and supports the health of mothers and infants. Therefore, in the future, the author, health care workers, and health care facilities are expected to improve the quality of care and adhere to midwifery care standards so that the care provided is more optimal.
