

### **Appendix 1. Synopsis of The Little Prince (1943)**

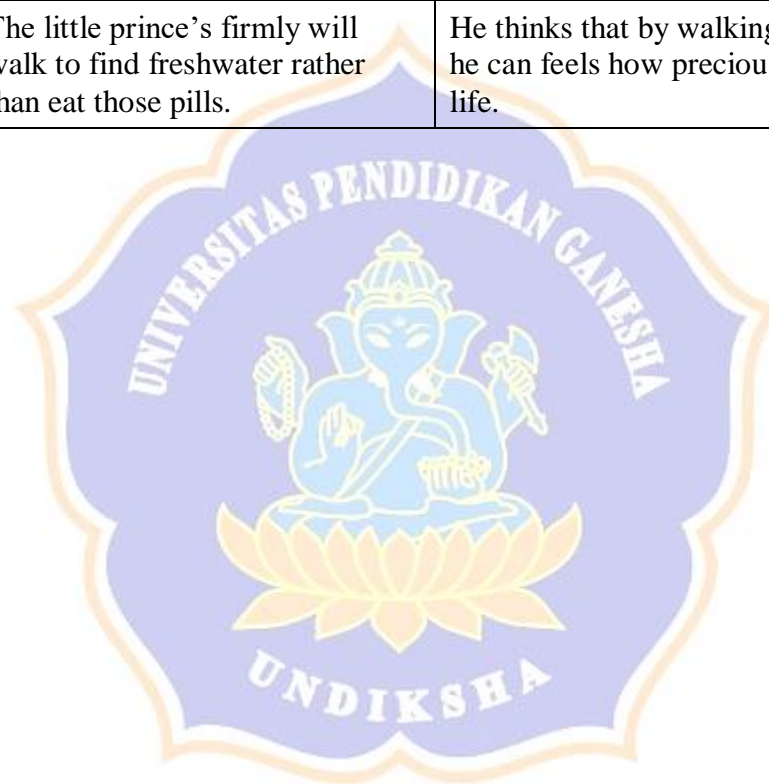
