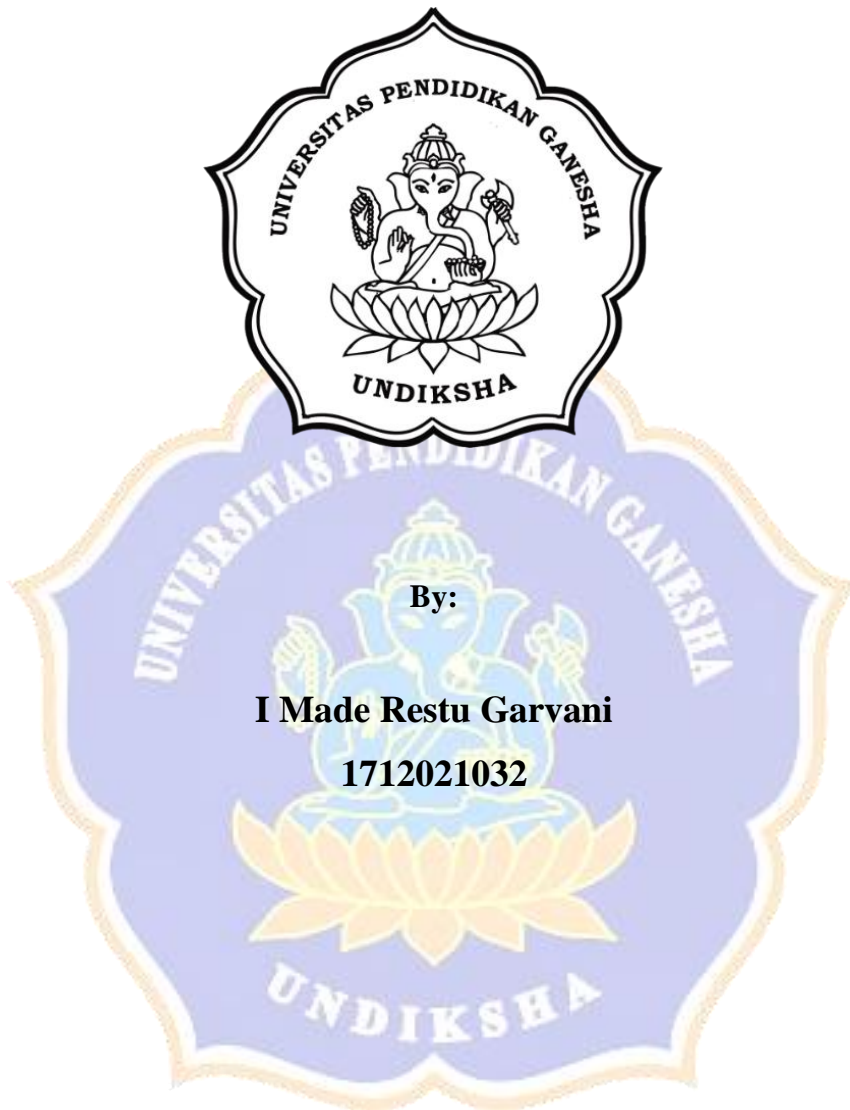

[ɑ:] : back, open, neutral vocoid
[ɪ] : front, close-mid, spread vocoid
[i:] : front, close, spread vocoid
[o] : back, close-mid, rounded vocoid
[u:] : back, close, rounded vocoid
[e] : front, open-mid, spread vocoid
[e:] : front, close-mid, spread vocoid
[ɔ] : back, open, rounded vocoid
[ɔ:] : back, open-mid, rounded vocoid
[p] : voiceless, bilabial, stop/plosive consonant
[b] : voiced, bilabial, stop/plosive consonant
[ɓ] : voiced, bilabial, implosive consonant
[t] : voiceless, alveolar, stop/plosive consonant
[f] : voiceless, labiodental, fricative consonant
[d] : voiced, alveolar, stop/plosive consonant
[ɗ] : voiced, alveolar, implosive consonant

- [h] : voiceless, glottal, fricative consonant
- [ç] : voiceless, palatal, fricative consonant
- [j] : voiced, palatal, fricative consonant
- [l] : voiced, alveolar, lateral consonant
- [m] : voiced, bilabial, nasal consonant
- [n] : voiced, alveolar, nasal consonant
- [ɲ] : voiced, velar, nasal consonant
- [k] : voiceless, velar, stop/plosive consonant
- [g] : voiced, velar, stop consonant
- [ʔ] : voiceless, glottal, stop consonant
- [r] : voiced, alveolar, rolled consonant
- [s] : voiceless, alveolar, fricative consonant
- [w] : voiced, bilabial, approximant consonant
- [y] : voiced, palatal, approximant consonant



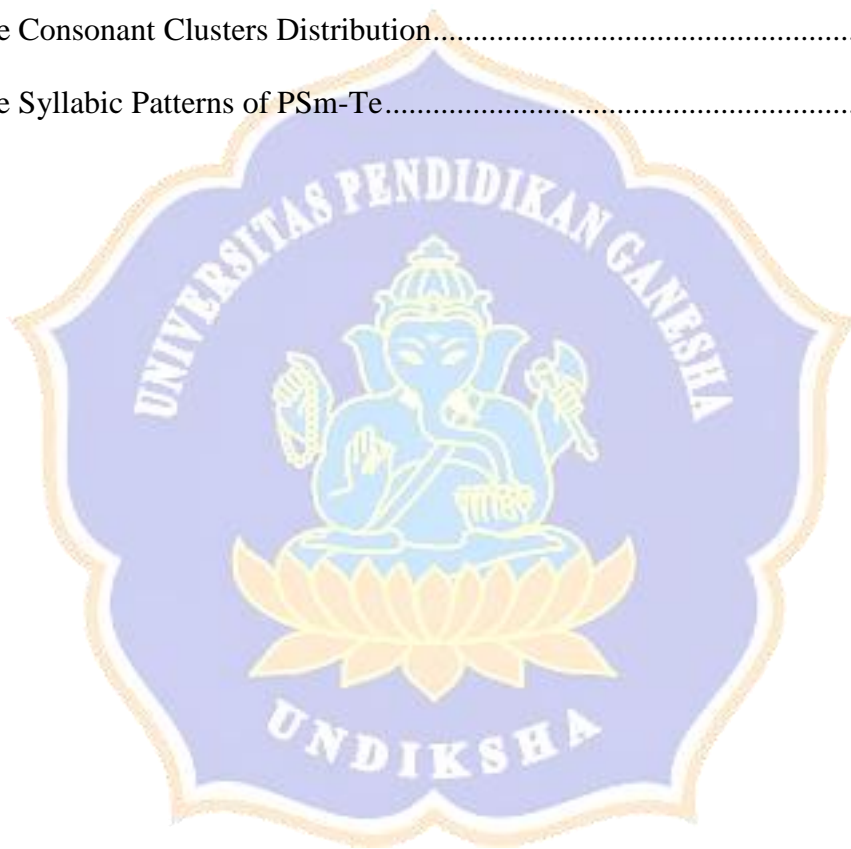
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
