

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTIONS

1.1 Background of Study

The curriculum of Diploma 3 English Study Program, Department of Foreign Language, Faculty of Languages and Arts, Ganesha University of Education has several ESP (English for Specific Purposes) courses which are taught including English for Food and Beverage Service, Basic English for Front Office, Advanced English for Front Office, Basic English for Guiding, English for Telephone Operator, English for Sales and Marketing and Advanced English for Guiding. In supporting learning one of ESP (English for Specific Purposes) lessons, especially English for Food and Beverage Service, it is necessary to have supporting teaching materials that need to be used in teaching. Of course, these learning support materials are useful for helping students in learning and teacher or lecturer in teaching to understand better the words needed in these subjects. Food and beverage service is part of the food and beverage department. The food and beverage service has to be in charge of providing services in the form of serving food and drinks to guests. The types of drinks served included mixed drinks (Jeje, 2019).

Based on the observation and experienced in learning English for Food and Beverage Service, no dictionary was used. The teaching materials used are modules and several videos about food and beverage service. Usually, the lecturer gives students directions to look for the material needed first and will be presented then evaluated by the lecturer and given additional justification and material. After that, it is practiced directly. The lecturer also provides real examples of the tools used in the field of food and beverage service.

Since there was no dictionary used, it was important to develop a dictionary, particularly for Food and Beverage Service. This dictionary can later make the students easier to learn and interpret the terms or terminologies in Food and

Beverage Service. In addition, of course, it can expand skills and knowledge in the Food and Beverage Service field, which will also be very useful in the world of works such as Restaurants, Hotels, Bar, Cruise Ship, Airlines, Trains, Companies, Schools, Colleges, Hospitals, Prisons, etc. Therefore this research was aimed to make a dictionary of English for Food and Beverage Service that can be used not only for the student of Diploma 3 English Study Program but also for students who learn English for the hospitality industry.

1.2 Scope of the Study

This study was about the developing dictionary for English for Food and Beverage Service. This study created a dictionary that can help interpret English words or terms, specifically English for Food and Beverage Service. This dictionary also included pictures to make it easier to understand and remember the terms or vocabularies used in the field of Food and Beverage Service.
