31. As its name, Gili Putih is white sand in the middle of the sea.
32. The small island is called "Gili,"
33. and the land has white sand called "Putih," which means white.
34. So, Gili Putih is a small white island in the middle of the sea.
35. When in high tide, you can find land with an area of only 600 square meters.
36. If it is receding, the land will connect Gili Putih with Penggambetan beach about 1.5 km.

37. Because this beach is in the middle of the sea,
38. you need to rent a boat or motorboat at the Bangsal port in Sumberkima village to go to this beach.
39. It will take 10-25 minutes by fishing boat to Gili Putih beach.
40. You have to pay about 350-400 thousand rupiahs a boat for five passengers.
41. This beach is an uninhabited place.
42. None of the trees grew in this place before being managed,
43. but now it has started to be managed,
44. and several coconut trees have been planted
45. to make this small island has a more beautiful view.
46. There is also a swing and haven for the visitors.
47. The seawater surrounds this beach as clear as crystals,
48. so besides photogenic and instagramable pictures, you can enjoy the underwater ecosystem.
49. You can join the local fisherman on this beach to go fishing.
50. You are spending your time to see the sunset from this beach also a perfect thing to do.
